URBAN INDIGENOUS VACCINE PRE-REGISTRATION

Everyone living in Kenora who identifies as Metis or Urban Indigenous (First Nation person not living on a First Nation Territory) is welcome to pre-register for upcoming COVID-19 vaccination clinics.

Clinics for Urban Indigenous and Metis people 18+ will begin the week of March 22 with those over the age of 65 being the first priority. Clinic dates and capacity will depend on vaccine availability.

Pre-registration is encouraged to assist with scheduling and determining the amount of vaccine required.

Appointments will be required for all vaccine clinics.

If you have any of the following medical conditions, you must speak with your doctor, nurse practitioner, or specialist to ensure the vaccine is safe for you:

- Compromised immune system (chemotherapy, radiation, etc.)
- Autoimmune disease (lupus, arthritis, etc.)
- Pregnant or breastfeeding
- Severe allergic reaction to a previous immunization
